How to apply for a shopper's card

Who is entitled to buy at SOMA?

You are entitled to buy at SOMA if:

- 1. Your main residence is in Vienna.
- 2. Your monthly income is below:

for singles: € 1.572.- (12 times a year) or € 1.348.- (14 times a year)
for couples: € 2.358.- (12 times a year) or €2.021.- (14 times a year)

• for every **child**: **plus € 472.-** (12 times a year) or € 405.- (14 times a year)

How to get a shopper's card for SOMA? (= buying permit for SOMA)

The shopper's card will be issued **per household**.

You will have to present the following documents:

- the current residence registration forms (Meldezettel) of <u>all</u> persons living in your household
- 2. the recent statements of income of all persons over 18 years of age (living in your household) or for those over age 18 still attending school: a certificate of school attendance
- 3. photo identification

If you are in possession of a "Mobilpass", you can present the "Mobilpass" instead of a statement of income.

Where do you get your shopper's card for SOMA?

- In the neighbourhood centers (Nachbarschaftszentren) of Wiener Hilfswerk (by appointment only)
- In the SOMA office: Neustiftgasse 73-75, 1070 Wien (mon. - fri.: 10:00 – 13:00)

If you want someone else to do your shopping for you!

If you want someone else to do your shopping with your shopper's card, this person has to be registered in your shopper's card. For this purpose we need a photo identification of the designated person.
